Concert master of the London Philharmonic Orchestra, Professor at the CNSMDP in Paris and the Folkwang University of the Arts in Essen (Germany), every year he runs a series of masterclasses at the best schools in the world, including the celebrated Curtiss Institute in Philadelphia and the renowned Peabody Institute in Baltimore.

Boris Garlitsky sits on the jury for the international violinist competitions: the Michael Hill competition in New Zealand, the Isang Yun competition in Korea, the Jascha Heifetz competition in Lithuania and others.

Boris first began playing the violin under the tutelage of his father, Mikhail Garlitsky, an outstanding teacher and creator of the famous "Step-by-step" school for young violinists. Later he graduated from the Moscow Music Conservatory, having been taught by Professor Yuri Yankelevich and joined the "Moscow Virtuosi" orchestra started by V. Spivakov.

In the 1980s Boris Garlitsky triumphed at the Paganini International Competition for violinists in Genoa. Since then, he has played as a soloist around the globe, among others with the London Philharmonic Orchestra, the Vienna Radio Orchestra, the Chamber Orchestra of Philadelphia as well as the Milan based Giuseppe Verdi Orchestra. His interpretations of Shostakovich's violin concerto with the Orchestre National de Lyon were praised in the press. "The intensity and irresistible force of persuasion brought to it by all the skill of Boris Garlitsky was worthy of the work's first interpreter, David Oistrakh", the Lyon Figaro commented.

Mr. Garlitsky is an active participator in several international music festivals. He regularly performs at the festivals and radio broadcasts in France, Italy, the USA and in the United Kingdom. The maestro's chamber repertoire is also amazingly rich. He has recorded for BBC, Naxos, Chandos and Polymnie.

Today, Mr. Garlitsky devotes a large amount of his time to education. He commands an uncompromising non-mechanical level of violin mastery. To play perfectly and to play with style is what matters for the Professor, meaning the "old school" which cultivates sensitive and insightful performance and that's the reason we study, rehearse and perform.

An intensive master class for 5-6 violin students with Mr Garlitsky will take place between **15 and 20 November 2017** as part of the "Masters School" educational programme by the Trans-Siberian Art Festival under the leadership of Vadim Repin. A participants' concert will be held in

the Main Hall of Energia Concert Hall as the conclusion of the master classes as well as an audience meeting with the maestro.

Masterclass Regulations

Five to six students at **professional music institutions** will be enrolled for the masterclasses. The participants will be selected by the respective professor on the basis of the application submitted to “The Masters School” Registration team, the deadline is 30 September 2017. Application forms are to be sent to the following email address: energy.masterclass@transsiberianfestival.com

The Application must include the following items:

- Copy of a passport/ID document
- Participant’s artistic CV with a recent photo
- Letters of recommendation from professors at music institutions
- An active link to a video recording of a performance by the Participant (duration: 15 min)

The masterclass participant’s fees are **30 000 roubles**. Applicants may apply for scholarship funding (the Scholarship Application form is in **Appx 2**).

Accommodation information for participants travelling from other cities will be provided once the selection process is complete.
